



SPRING LEARNING 2

In foundation this half term we will be learning:

Literacy:

We will be looking at key words in story books, reading them and writing them! We will learn what a poet is and write poems of our own. We will be listening to and joining in with rhymes. We will be listening appropriately to stories and relating our own experiences to them.

Numeracy:

We will be learning to recognise tall/long and heavy/light. We will begin to measure and weigh items using non standard measures. We will extend our knowledge of number by comparing numbers and recognising less and more. We will learn to recognise 3D shapes and the coins 1p,2p,5p,10p.

Knowledge and Understanding Of The World:

We will be learning about People Who Help Us. This will include the Post Office, emergency services, refuse collectors, mums and dads! We will learn the journey of a letter, how to recycle and how to cross the road safely. In ICT we will be using the mouse and arrow keys to direct simulations on the screen. We will be programming roamer to move between destination cards. In science we will be learning about forces and electricity, looking at the forces of push and pull. We will conduct a fair test to find out how we can make the toy cars travel a further distance. We will learn what uses electricity and how to stay safe with electricity.

P.S.H.E.:

We will think of the moral and emotional aspects of People Who Help Us, such as giving up things in order to help others. We will tell the story of the first easter and explore the theme of new life.

Creative Development:

In art we will be learning how to weave and sew using running stitch. We will

also experiment with fabric crayons. We will then bring together everything we have learnt over the last term to design and make an easter card. In music we will continue to develop the skill of keeping time with a steady beat, while enjoying a range of songs and learning to play percussion instruments effectively.

Physical Development:

In gymnastics we will be moving around the hall traveling on different parts of our bodies, we will be using all the space in the hall and become aware of our own working space. We will also be learning how to follow simple plans to take out some of the PE equipment. In dance we will move our bodies to a range of music to the theme of icicles and water, Mr. Jelly and Mr. Strong and Wriggling William!
